Missouri Coalition for the Environment (MCE) is an independent citizen-led environmental organization in the state of Missouri. Their focus is to bring awareness to environmental issues such as clean water, clean air, clean energy and a healthy environment. MCE began in 1969 at an environmental conference held at the Missouri Botanical Garden. In their 50+ years they've contributed so much to environmental causes. In 2014, MCE released the first St. Louis Regional Food Study which sought to understand the connections between food, health, and environment within 150 miles of St. Louis. In conjunction with Operation Food Search, MCE launched the Greater St. Louis Area Gleaning Program. Gleaning allows farmers to donate unwanted food to Operation Food Search's network of over 200 food pantries.

## **Known & Grown STL:**

The MCE program I want to focus on is the Known & Grown STL program. Known & Grown STL seeks to promote humane & chemical-free farmers within 150 miles of St. Louis. Known & Grown visits each farm to ensure they meet the standards for Good Stewardship Practices prior to promoting them. Known & Grown STL uses its platform to raise awareness of the systemic racism of the American food system and the impact it's had on BIPOC farmers. Each farmer in the Known & Grown program

is given a profile on their website. This profile lists the conservation practices, products, contact information, etc. of each farm.

On their website, there is a local food locator tool. This tool allows you to look up various food offerings by zip code.

Known & Grown STL also began a mentorship program in 2021. This program allows a beginner or traditionally disadvantaged

farmer an opportunity to improve or expand their environmentally responsible practices.

They also have a podcast, Earthworms on the Farm, where they interview Known & Grown farmers.

All St. Louis citizens have a right to healthy, pesticide-free food. Known & Grown STL is doing its part to bring about a healthier, more just food system.
